### Phase 3 Policy & Procedures

#### Facility and Social Distancing

- The manager, assistant manager, and lifeguard(s) on duty are in complete authority. Every person who uses the facilities must abide by their instructions.
- If, in the manager's opinion, any person is acting in such a manner as to endanger himself or any other person and their rightful enjoyment of the facility, the manager will eject such person immediately and report the violation to the Board of Directors for potential suspension.
- Colony must screen patrons for COVID-19 symptoms prior to admission. Admission will be refused to anyone who appears physically ill to include, cough, fever, difficulty breathing, serious skin abrasions, infections, sores, colds, coughs, shortness of breath, fever, inflamed eyes, bandages, or at the discretion of the pool manager.
- Snack shop, playroom, baby pool, playground, basketball court, will be closed.
- Low and high diving boards will open on alternate days.
- Bathrooms will be open to one member at a time.
- Members must adhere to the traffic flow pattern inside and outside of the facility.
- Members must promptly gather all personal items and leave the facility via the designated exit in order for employees to properly sanitize the facility every hour and 45 minutes.
- Seating on the pool deck will be permitted. Members must bring their own seating and maintain at least ten feet of spacing between persons who are not members of the same household while on deck.
- Members are responsible for maintaining at least 10 feet of spacing between persons who are not members of the same household while in the pool.
- Pool toys will be permitted with the exclusion of floats, torpedoes, and balls. No throwing toys.
- 4 persons per lane will be permitted in the lap swim area.
- Due to Covid-19, Lifeguards are prohibited from helping individuals in and out of the water (unless it is a rescue situation).
- Children 10 years and younger and swimmers that are not able to swim unassisted must be accompanied by an adult member.
- Children 11 years and older may swim unaccompanied with the expectation that they maintain proper social distancing in the pool and on deck.

#### Guests

- All guests must be accompanied by a member.
- Persons will be admitted as guests when accompanied by a member over the age of 13.
- The guest fee will be five dollars (\$5.00) per day.
- Members must register their guests upon entering the pool enclosure and pay guest fees. No one under 13 years of age will be allowed to bring in a guest unless signed in by an adult member.
