### Phase 2 Policy & Procedure Agreement

#### Facility and Social Distancing

- The manager, assistant manager, and lifeguard(s) on duty are in complete authority. Every person who uses the facilities must abide by their instructions.
- If, in the manager's opinion, any person is acting in such a manner as to endanger himself or any other person and their rightful enjoyment of the facility, the manager will eject such person immediately and report the violation to the Board of Directors for potential suspension.
- Colony must screen patrons for COVID-19 symptoms prior to admission. Admission will be refused to anyone who appears physically ill to include, cough, fever, difficulty breathing, serious skin abrasions, infections, sores, colds, coughs, shortness of breath, fever, inflamed eyes, bandages, or at the discretion of the pool manager.
- Bathrooms, snack shop, playroom, diving boards, baby pool, playground, basketball court, diving boards, will be closed.
- Members must adhere to the traffic flow pattern inside and outside of the facility.
- Forms and information will be posted on the gate. Questions will be answered via Facebook and email.
- Only Members with a reservation will be permitted entrance. Members must enter individually for screening when indicated by the front desk employee.
- Members must proceed directly to the pool deck.
- Members must promptly leave the facility via the designated exit at the end of their swim session in order for employees to properly sanitize the facility between each reservation time slot.
- Members must bring their own equipment and seating.
- Seating on the pool deck will be permitted. Members must bring their own chairs and maintain at least ten feet of spacing between persons who are not members of the same household.
- Swimming will be limited to three (3) persons per lane with ten feet of physical distance per swimmer.
- Due to Covid-19, Lifeguards are prohibited from helping individuals in and out of the water (unless it is a rescue situation). Please take this into account when reserving swimming lanes.
- Children 10 years and younger and swimmers that are not able to swim unassisted must be accompanied by an adult member with a separate reservation.

#### Reservations

- Reservations must be made online via Signup Genius.
- Signup Genius reservations slots will be released each Saturday. Each individual member is allowed two initial reservations for the week.
- Each individual member may sign up for an additional two reservations on Sunday if there are any remaining lane reservations available.

- An unlimited amount of reservations may be made on Monday.
- Members must provide the name of their guests in the member's online reservation.
- Habitual cancelations and/or no-shows could result in suspension of facility privileges for the remainder of Phase 2.
- Failure to abide by the reservation policies could result in suspension of facility privileges for the remainder of Phase 2.

Guests

- All guests must be accompanied by a member.
- Persons will be admitted as guests when accompanied by a member over the age of 13.
- The guest fee will be five dollars (\$5.00) per day.
- Members must register their guests upon entering the pool enclosure and pay guest fees. No one under 13 years of age will be allowed to bring in a guest unless signed in by an adult.
